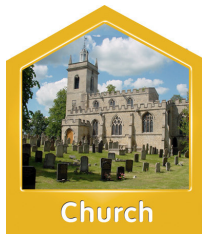

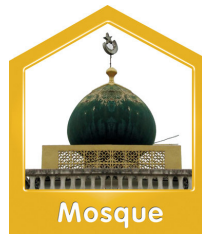

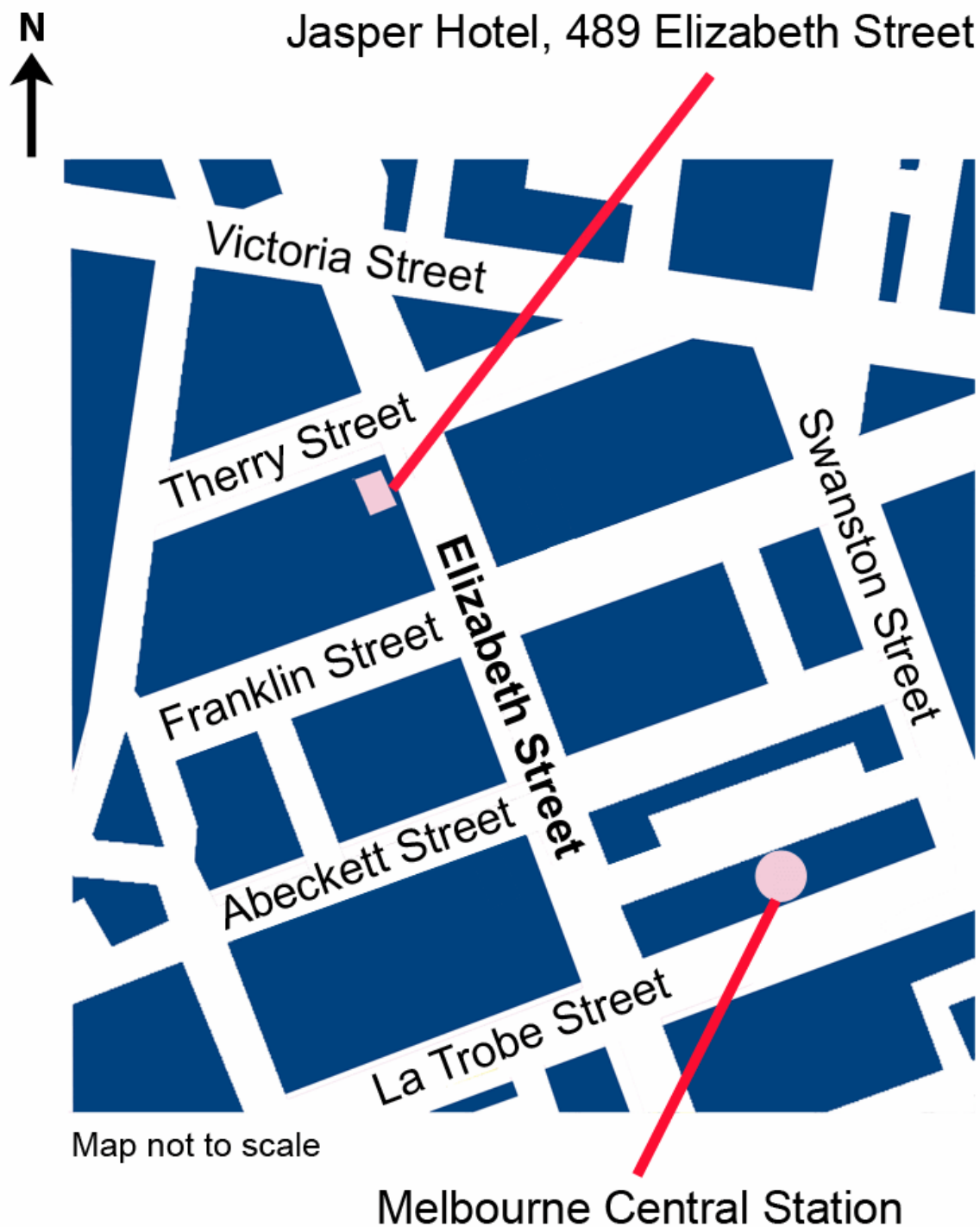

How to get to the Jasper Hotel

Tram

Some trams get to the city from the north and north-western suburbs. Tram numbers 19, 57, 59 and 68 go along Elizabeth Street. These trams stop outside the Jasper Hotel. The trams are not wheelchair accessible.

Train

You can get to the Jasper Hotel from Melbourne Central Station. Leave the station using the **Elizabeth Street exit** at the corner of La Trobe and Elizabeth Streets. The Jasper Hotel is 200 metres north along Elizabeth Street.

By car

Accessible parking bays are at the Queen Victoria Market on Therry Street.
